- Accessories and tools for your medium - brushes, water cups, sharpeners, compositional aids, etc
- Light weight easel, backing board or sketch book
- Small bag for trash - carry out what you bring in please
- Lunch, snacks, drinks
- Sunscreen and bug spray
- Hat with brim
- Rain jacket
- Rags or paper towels
- Umbrella or sunshade - optional
- Chair, stool, sit-upon - optional
- Portable table - optional
